

Caladiums



Caladiums are tropical plants growing from tubers, best known for their long lasting colorful foliage. They are used as house plants or summer landscape in shady spots.

Plant them in warm, moist well drained soil. Caladiums grow best in partial shade. They will perform reasonably well in full shade but the color may not be as outstanding.

Because Caladiums are basically all leaves, they thrive with regular fertilizer. Watch out for a fungus that can cause the lower leaves to develop light brown spots, remove the diseased leaves as they appear.
