

Marigold - 'Durango'

To add a modern touch to the traditional marigold, check out Durango Marigolds! They sport small, ruffled flowers, in vibrant and contemporary colors and combinations. Their garden performance and nonstop beauty is exceptional!

Durango Marigolds are petite, ruffled flowers that grow on sturdy stems above deeply divided foliage. They are a fast growing annual that look fabulous surrounding a garden's edge, window boxes and containers. They are fragrant, have scented foliage, attract bees, are heat and frost tolerant and are very low maintenance. They require full sun (at least 6 hours each day) and prefer average well drained soil. They only need medium watering, so you should water them a few times a week. Remove spent flowers and avoid watering late in the day. They grow in a very upright habit and will brighten any sunny bed or add a bright spark of color to any container.
