## Geranium - 'Americana'

The Americana Geranium produces a deep green foliage with a faint zonal pattern. These geraniums are desired most for their beautiful foliage, semi-double blooms extending above the foliage, tolerance for heat and its mounding habit. This is a great annual for Spring, Summer, and Fall. With the mounding habit of the American Geranium, this is a lovely choice for mixed containers and beds. The Americana Geranium prefers full sun to partial shade and a bit milder climates. It matures to about 12-18" tall and about 14-22" in wide and prefers average, moist but well-drained soil. Trimming back dead blossoms encourages new blooms. Please remember, containers aren't as drought resistant, they may need a little extra TLC and consistent watering if in containers!

Cranberry Red produces velvety red blooms that hover gracefully above the green foliage with a faint bronze zonal pattern. The Pink Splash produces clusters of lavender-pink with deep magenta splashes near the center above the green foliage with a very faint zonal pattern. The Rose Mega Splash is very similar to the Pink Splash with the addition of more and deeper magenta markings on the blossoms.
