## Diascia - 'Darla'

Diascia is commonly referred to as Twinspur. This is a great annual for Spring, Summer, and Fall. Diascia can also be considered a tender perennial in mild Winter areas. Diascia Darla Light Pink grows wiry stems that produce delicate pink blossoms that have two rear spurs filled with nectar. The nectar will attract butterflies, bees, and hummingbirds. Diascia blooms continuously, only slowing in extreme heat but picking back up as the weather cools. Trimming back the plant may be helpful in producing more blooms once the temperature starts to cool. It has a mounding to trailing habit, grows 10-14" tall and spreads up to 24" in width. This is great for edges of beds and containers. Diascia likes full to partial sun and average soil, but if in a container, it will need to be watered more regularly. Diascia thrives in fertile, fast draining soil. Diascia is also available in Darla White and Darla Red.
