## Verbena - 'Quartz'

Quartz Verbenas are wonderful all-season annuals that look brilliant in containers, beds and hanging baskets.

Quartz Waterfall Mix features a sparkling blue hue, lavender blue with eye, and solid white. Quartz Merlot Mix showcases deep red, solid white and red with eye flowers. Quartz Red w/ Eye will bring you bright red blooms with white centers. Quartz White is a clear solid white. Quartz Purple provides clusters of bright purple blossoms among its green foliage.

Quartz verbenas are very easy to grow and are strong garden performers. They are spreading, mounded plants that produce large beautiful florets and sport dark green foliage. They are early flowering and have a branched habit. The Quartz series performs great in cool weather and will tolerate light frost. They will also cooperate in high heat and are drought tolerant. You should keep their soil very well drained and avoid watering late in the evening. Make sure they get at least 6 hours of sun a day for the best looking verbena results. Be sure to deadhead spent flowers to ensure continuous flowering.
