Watermelon Charleston Gray

This Charleston Gray watermelon produces a large cylindrical shaped fruit averaging 30 pounds and 24" long.

The skin is light greenish gray with a sweet red flesh.

It is recommend to plant in moist but well drained soil with lots of room to spread.

Hint: You will know the fruit is ripe when you thump it and hear a dull hollow sound.

Harvest Instructions

On the bottom side of the melon, where it rests atop the soil, a bald spot that is light green to white appears. Only when this bald spot changes to pale yellow or cream is the melon ripe.

Also, the nearby vine tendrils and stem connecting the ripe melon to the vine begin to shrivel or dry
